

Masculine and Feminine

Key Information

Nouns are words that name things, people, places and ideas. In French, all nouns are either masculine or feminine.

masculine

Masculine nouns have le (the) or un (a/an) in front of them.

feminine

Feminine nouns have la (the) or une (a/an) in front of them.

Words starting with a vowel have l' in front of them instead of le or la.



remember

When you learn a new French word, you also need to learn if it's masculine (m) or feminine (f).



Write the correct determiner for each noun depending on whether it's masculine or feminine. The first one has been done for you.


